1 **AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2020-0224, VERSION 1**

2 On page 3, beginning on line 62, strike lines 62 through 66, and insert:

3 "SECTION 2. The Juneteenth holiday created under this ordinance is subject to  
4 available funding resources and bargaining, taking into account the full range of pay and  
5 benefits available to employees through the county's total compensation framework, as  
6 well as potential impacts to existing county services.

7 SECTION 3. This ordinance takes effect January 1, 2022."

9 ***EFFECT: Strikes Section 2 authorizing agreements with labor organizations to***  
10 ***provide the same additional holiday paid leave as provided for nonrepresented***  
11 ***employees under this ordinance; and providing that, if the agreements address no***  
12 ***additional subjects or have no additional terms, they will have the force of law upon***  
13 ***execution by the parties. Replaces the stricken section with a new Section 2, providing***  
14 ***that the additional paid holiday is subject to funding and bargaining, taking into***  
15 ***account pay and benefits provided through the Total Compensation framework; and***  
16 ***potential impacts to existing services. A new Section 3 provides an effective date of***  
17 ***January 1, 2022.***
