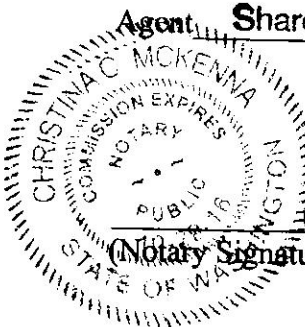

Ordinance 17837**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council (the Council) held a public hearing in the Council Chambers on the 10th Floor of the King County Courthouse (516 Third Avenue, Seattle, WA) on Monday, June 23, 2014, beginning at 1:30 PM. The purpose of this public hearing was to consider adoption of Proposed Substitute Ordinance 2013-0480 (Ordinance 17837), adopting amendments to King County Code Titles 16 (Building Code) and 17 (Fire Code).

SUMMARY:

Ordinance 17837 adopts local amendments to the International Building and Fire Codes that:

- Reflect and carry forward unique King County protections such as noise transmission standards for properties located near Seattle International Airport.
- Update County Code language to be consistent with the state and model codes and address changes to International Code numbering.
- Modify building codes for residential buildings which house either home occupations or home industries, to provide additional flexibility to home businesses without presenting any public health or safety concerns.
- Exempt from building permit requirements installation of roof-mounted solar panels that meet specified loading standards and smaller wind turbines.

The ordinance also repeals several King County amendments to the building, fire, and plumbing codes that are now covered by the international and Uniform codes.
