NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council has adopted Ordinance 14525 on November 25, 2002. King County provides this notice of adoption and enactment pursuant to RCW 36.70A.290(2)(b).

SUMMARY

Ordinance 14525 adopts school impact fees to be collected during 2003 from all non-exempt new residential development in the unincorporated portions of the Tahoma, Federal Way, Riverview, Issaquah, Snoqualmie Valley, Highline, Lake Washington, Kent, Northshore, Enumclaw, Fife and Auburn school districts. All fees collected and all interest earned are distributed to the respective school districts for expenditure on capital facilities projects, identified in their adopted capital facilities plans, that are necessary to accommodate residential growth within the districts.

The proposed fees by school district are shown below.
