1 **STRIKING AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED MOTION 2024-0404, VERSION 1**

2 On page 1, beginning on line 4, strike everything through page 2, line 17, and insert:

3 "WHEREAS, a vacancy will exist in the position of state representative for the  
4 33rd legislative district due to the passage of Motion XXXXX (Proposed Motion 2024-  
5 0405) appointing a 33rd legislative district state representative to serve as state senator  
6 for that legislative district (the "vacancy"), and

7 WHEREAS, Article II, Section 15 of the Washington state Constitution prescribes  
8 the process for filling vacancies in either house of the state legislature, and

9 WHEREAS, the candidates must reside in the 33rd legislative district and be of  
10 the same political party as the legislator whose office is being vacated, and

11 WHEREAS, the 33rd legislative district Democratic Precinct Committee officers  
12 have met to consider candidates for the position, and

13 WHEREAS the King County Democratic Central Committee has submitted the  
14 names of three constitutionally qualified candidates to fill the vacancy for the remainder  
15 of the current term as well as to fill the vacancy that will exist as of January 13, 2025.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:  
17 \_\_\_\_\_ is hereby appointed to the position of state  
18 representative for the 33rd legislative district in the Washington State House of  
19 Representatives for the remainder of the current term as well as to fill the vacancy that  
20 will exist as of January 13, 2025. \_\_\_\_\_ shall continue to serve  
21 until a successor is elected at the next general election and the successor has qualified."
