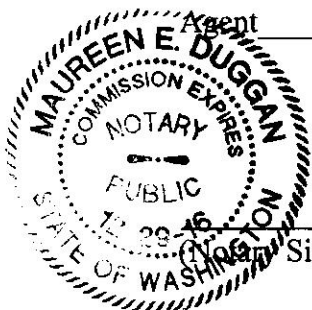

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council (the Council) held a public hearing in the Council Chambers on the 10th Floor of the King County Courthouse (516 Third Avenue, Seattle, WA) on Monday, November 17, 2014, beginning at 11:00 AM. The purpose of this public hearing was to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2014-0380 (Ordinance 17940), an ordinance renewing for six-months an existing moratorium on the establishment or location of medical marijuana dispensaries and collective gardens asserted to be or actually authorized under Chapter 181, Laws of Washington 2011, and chapter 69.51A RCW.

### SUMMARY:

Ordinance 17940 is renewing for six-months an existing moratorium on the establishment or location of medical marijuana dispensaries and collective gardens asserted to be or actually authorized under Chapter 181, Laws of Washington 2011, and chapter 69.51A RCW. The executive will transmit a report at the end of the 2015 state legislative session that includes an update on what the legislature adopted into the laws of the state, and the status of the recreational and medical marijuana regulatory systems; and recommendations on adoption of appropriate land use regulations.
