He also proposed that the workplan be revised, with a specific lens of supporting covid response and addressing the public health impacts of racism, and that the Board review the draft workplan, and bring it back for consideration at the July meeting.

Patty Hayes, Director, Public Health Seattle & King County, thanked the Board, and those that have made public comments, for having the conversation about racism as a public health crisis. She announced the application for Phase II has been submitted; that there has been a large increase in testing across the County; and that last weekend Tina Knowles Lawson, of I Did My Part Campaign, and Beyonce's, Be Good

Initiative, partnered with the Health Department and other local organizations to provide free drive through testing in the South end, as well as providing free essential supplies and care packages to the community.
