1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 1:44 p.m. The meeting was recessed at 2:37 p.m. The Chair reconvened the meeting at 3:18 p.m.

County Executive Ron Sims gave his 2008 Budget Address.

6. Reports on Special and Outside Committees

Mr. Phillips reported on Sound Transit. The staff reviewed the findings of a recently completed state performance audit, which dealt with Sound Transit's central link light rail project. Mr. Phillips indicated there was a public hearing on the audit and the staff was directed to submit a plan for implementing the balance of the audit's recommendations. The public has 60 days to provide written comments.

Ms. Hague reported on the Eastside Transportation Partnership. The members heard a presentation on the Puget Sound Regional Council's 20/30 transportation forecast. Ms. Hague described the term "Trip Tour" which means stops along the way. The members adopted changes to bylaws.

Ms. Patterson briefed the Council on the Puget Sound Regional Council Transportation Policy Board. She referred to the recent Seattle Times article "Shifting Gears", which included some very positive news that the Puget Sound area residents are buying fewer cars, driving fewer miles and using more transit. The Board received a report on growth and transportation. She indicated our region is forecasted to experience tremendous growth, and by 2030 the central Puget Sound region will have nearly the same population as the San Francisco Bay area.

Mr. Phillips commented on his yearly rafting trip with citizens down the Cedar River.
