# 7. Michelle Clark, Executive Director, King County Flood Control District

The comment period will be sixty days and ends on January 29. A public hearing will be held on January 9 in the city of Kent. Ms. Clark reported that the Watershed Resource Inventory Area 9 Watershed Ecosystem Forum voted to include the King County Flood Control District as a member.

Josh Baldi, Director, King County Water and Land Resources Division, reported on the status of the Lower Green River systemwide improvement framework, Lower Russell Levee Setback project, transmittal of the King County Flood Control District Semi-Annual report, and filling of the vacant Assistant Director of Water and Land Resources Division position.
