Dear Councilmember Sullivan:

The enclosed ordinance, if approved, will appropriate \$70,211 to Adult and Juvenile Detention (Current Expense), and disappropriate \$70,211 from the Salary and Wage Contingency Fund (Current Expense) for the 2003 budget. This supplemental will implement the collective bargaining unit agreement between King County and employees represented by the Washington State Council of County and City Employees, Council 2, Local 21-AD.

When the 2003 budget was written, the impact of the COLA upon Adult and Juvenile Detention was unknown, and therefore not included in the budget. A reserve was set aside in the CX Salary and Wage Contingency to plan for the COLA. All step and merit was accounted for in the 2003 budget. The \$70,211 impact is the result of the COLA, and therefore is proposed to come out of the planned reserve in the CX Salary and Wage Contingency. The revenue source for this supplemental appropriation is the Salary and Wage Contingency (CX) fund.

The settlement reached is a product of good-faith bargaining between King County and the union. The agreement compares favorably with other settlements and is within our capacity to finance.
