NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington on the 11th day of June, 2018 at 1:30 PM, to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2018-0231.

Proposed Ordinance 2018-0231 does the following:

Makes a determination of the sewer rate for the year 2019 that must be charged in order to meet the monetary requirements (administration, ope-erating, and maintenance, repair and replacement costs) of the County's sewage disposal program. The proposed sewer rate for 2018 is \$45.33 per month per residential customer equivalent (RCE). By comparison, the 2018 sewer rate is \$44.22 per RCE per month.

Sever rate is 544.22 per RCE per month.

Sets the capacity charge for sewer connections occurring between and including January 1, 2019 and December 31, 2019. The capacity charge is the fee that is assessed against customers establishing new connections to ensure that those customers bear their eguitable share of the cost of new capacity-related sewage facilities necessary to serve them. The proposed capacity charge is 564.50 per month per RCE for fifteen years. By comparison, the 2018 capacity charge is 562.60 per RCE per month for fifteen years.
