1 AN ORDINANCE authorizing the provision of radio
2 communication services to external agencies; and adding a
3 new section to K.C.C. chapter 2.58.

4 PREAMBLE:

5 The King County Code established the emergency radio communications
6 services system to improve the ability of government agencies throughout
7 King County to respond in a coordinated manner to a major disaster and
8 enhance the safety of front-line emergency response personnel. Executive
9 Policy FES 10-1 (A-P), executed in 1988 gave the authority for King
10 County radio communication services, which was formerly radio
11 communication and repair shop, to provide all user agencies the policies
12 and procedures relating to planning, engineering, installation, transferring,
13 maintenance, and administration support. Over the past thirty-four years
14 King County radio communication services, which is currently known as
15 the emergency radio communications division, has been providing that
16 service to external agencies providing a critical public safety service by
17 maintaining the operation of both the 800Mhz emergency radio system
18 infrastructure and the mobile and portable subscriber radios. This
19 ordinance will authorize the continuity of public safety services provided
20 by the emergency radio communications division throughout the region.

Ordinance 19632

21 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

22 NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. There is hereby added to K.C.C. chapter 2.58 a

23 new section to read as follows:

24 The emergency radio communications division is authorized to enter into service

25 contracts with all city, county, regional, state, special district, tribal and federal agencies,

- 26 nonprofit corporations, private customers, and any emergency radio subscribers, for the
27 purpose of providing radio subscriber services.


