Dear Councilmember Zahilay:

Please find enclosed the Levy Engagement Plan, as required by Ordinance 19956, Section 6, Proviso P7. This report provides an overview of King County's voter-approved property tax levies, along with early plans for the Best Starts for Kids Levy renewal in 2027.

King County's six voter-approved levies include the Best Starts for Kids Levy; the Crisis Care Centers Levy; the Veterans, Senior, and Human Services Levy; the Parks Levy; the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Levy, and the Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS) Levy. Best Starts for Kids is the sole voter-approved levy up for renewal in the 2026-2027 biennium, and no new levies are currently planned. The Department of Community and Human Services and Public Health – Seattle & King County are in the early stages of planning for the Best Starts for Kids Levy renewal, including engagement with Councilmembers and the community.
