RECITALS

WHEREAS, from its inception, the Fire District was initially known as Fire Protection District No. 36, King County, and then in November 1992, following the passage of King County Ordinance 10655, known thereafter as the Woodinville Fire and Life Safety District;

WHEREAS, the Fire District's Board of Fire Commissioners determined via a duly moved, seconded and approved motion at the Board's regularly scheduled meeting on May 3, 2010, that it is in the best interests of the Fire District to change its name to "Woodinville Fire & Rescue"; and

WHEREAS, RCW 52.30.060 provides a procedure for a fire protection district to change its name; and

NOW, THEREFORE, it is resolved by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Woodinville Fire and Life Safety District that the Fire District shall going-forward bear the name Woodinville Fire & Rescue. This resolution shall be effective once approved by the King County Council, pursuant to RCW 52.30.060.
