1 AN ORDINANCE relating to transportation concurrency;
2 adopting a requirement to include an annual report and
3 form an expert review panel to review transportation
4 concurrency updates; and amending Ordinance 14050,
5 Section 14, as amended, and K.C.C. 14.70.270.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

8 SECTION 1. Ordinance 14050, Section 14, as amended, and K.C.C. 14.70.270
9 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

10 A. The traffic model for concurrency shall be updated annually as part of the
11 budget process or when authorized by the county council by ordinance. The update
12 process shall include the most recently adopted roads CIP, updated traffic volumes and
13 updated information regarding issuance of concurrency certificates, development
14 approvals and development activity. The traffic model shall conform to the guidelines
15 and procedures described by the Federal Highway Administration in its publication
16 entitled Calibration and Adjustment of System Planning Models dated December 1990 or
17 its successor. Each update of the traffic model shall be used to produce a new

18 concurrency map and table of estimated vehicle trips for monitored zones. The
19 concurrency map and table of estimated vehicle trips for monitored zones shall be
20 submitted to council for its approval by ordinance. The updates of the traffic model shall
21 be deemed adequate for the purposes of concurrency analysis and the concurrency map
22 shall be used to determine the concurrency of proposed residential development projects.
23 The traffic model shall be used to prepare the concurrency map and to perform site
24 specific analysis for nonresidential projects.

25 B. An annual report shall be prepared by the road services division on the
26 concurrency program update. The annual report shall explain the technical assumptions,
27 land use changes, network changes and other parameters used to update the concurrency
28 model. The annual report shall be submitted to the council along with the annual update
29 required by subsection A. of this section. Eleven copies of the report shall be filed with
30 the clerk of the council, who shall retain the original and shall forward copies to each
31 councilmember and to the lead staff of the council's transportation committee, or its
32 successor.

33 C.1. An independent expert review panel on concurrency shall be established to:

34 a. review the annual report on the concurrency model update; and
35 b. evaluate proposed changes to the transportation concurrency process and
36 model developed by the road services division.

37 2. The panel shall be comprised of four to six persons and include
38 representation from the development community, the environmental community,
39 transportation planning professionals, the unincorporated area, the public at large and

40 multimodal transportation interest groups. Each representative shall be appointed by the
41 executive and confirmed by the council.

42 3. A summary of the panel's review of the annual report on the concurrency
43 model update and its evaluation of proposed changes to the transportation concurrency
44 process and model shall be included with the submittal of the annual report to the council.


45 D. The concurrency map is a result of the values inputted in to the traffic model,
46 as described in subsection A. of this section. The concurrency map indicates if a
47 concurrency zone does or does not comply with adopted TAM and travel time level of
48 service standards. Any changes to the concurrency status of a zone or zones on the
49 concurrency map other than those resulting from the model update process may only be
50 accomplished by the council, through an ordinance, by changing any combination of the

51 adopted TAM or travel time standards, or the list of funded projects in the most recently
52 adopted CIP.
