1 AN ORDINANCE approving the Shoreline Water District
2 2007 Water System Plan.

4 STATEMENT OF FACTS:

- 5 1. King County adopted K.C.C. chapter 13.24, which requires approval of
6 comprehensive plans for water and sewer utilities that distribute or obtain
7 water in unincorporated King County as a prerequisite for operating in
8 unincorporated King County, receiving approval for annexation proposals,
9 being granted right-of-way franchises and being given approval for right-
10 of-way construction permits. K.C.C. 13.24.060 prescribes the
11 requirements for approval of such plans, including consistency with state
12 and local planning requirements.
- 13 2. RCW 57.16. 010 requires that general comprehensive plans for water
14 districts must be submitted to and approved by the legislative authority
15 within whose boundaries all or a portion of the district lies.
- 16 3. King County last approved the Shoreline Water District Water System
17 Plan ("the plan") in 1991. Both Washington state Department of Health

18 and King County regulations require water system plans to be updated
19 every six years.

20 4. The Shoreline water district ("the district") is in King County and has
21 adopted a 2007 comprehensive water system plan.

22 5. King County has adopted a comprehensive plan that includes water
23 supply policies in its provisions for facilities and services (policies F-213
24 through F-245) that call for consistency with other adopted plans, support
25 for regional water supply planning, pursuit of reclaimed water, water
26 conservation and protection of water resources.

27 6. K.C.C. chapter 13.24 requires review of water system plans by the
28 utilities technical review committee, and a recommendation made to the
29 King County executive and council on the plan and the requirements
30 under K.C.C. chapter 13.24 and consistency with the King County
31 Comprehensive Plan. The utilities technical review committee has
32 reviewed the planning data and district operations and hereby finds:

33 a. The plan uses the population and employment forecasts developed by
34 the Puget Sound Regional Council for the district's service area, and is
35 consistent with population targets under the growth management act with
36 a customized forecast appropriately used;

37 b. The plan need not use King County land use classifications, as the
38 service area is located wholly within the incorporated cities of Shoreline
39 and Lake Forest Park;

40 c. The capital facility plan is adequate to meet anticipated facility and
41 service needs;

42 d. The plan is consistent with applicable state water quality laws,
43 including the evaluation of reclaimed water use; and

44 e. The plan is consistent with other pertinent county adopted plans and
45 policies.

46 7. The Washington state Department of Health approved the district's plan
47 on January 20, 2009.

48 8. The district completed a state Environmental Policy Act checklist and
49 issued a determination of nonsignificance for the issuance of the plan on
50 January 15, 2008.

51 9. The district's operations and facilities meet multiple existing statutory,
52 administrative and planning standards. As the district's operations,
53 facilities and planning meet the requirements of the King County Code
54 and are consistent with the King County Comprehensive Plan, the utilities
55 technical review committee recommends approval of the plan.


58 SECTION 1. The Shoreline Water District 2007 Water System Plan, Attachment

Ordinance 16558 was introduced on 5/4/2009 and passed by the Metropolitan King County Council on 6/22/2009, by the following vote:




