Proposed Substitute Ordinance 2012-0142**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 9th day of July, 2012, at 1:30 p.m., to consider adoption of Proposed Substitute Ordinance 2012-0142, amending Ordinance 14509, Section 4, and K.C.C. 7.01.010 and Ordinance 6798, Section 48, as amended, and K.C.C. 7.12, Article III, prohibiting the use of tobacco products in high-use areas in King County parks and recreation facilities and prescribing penalties. This notice is given in accordance with the provisions of RCW 36.32.120 (7) because the ordinance provides penalties for its violation.

SUMMARY

The King County Executive has concluded discussions with the Department of Natural Resources and Parks and Public Health - Seattle & King County and requested the County Council to adopt an ordinance that would amend Title Seven of the King County Code by adding a prohibition on the use of tobacco products in high-use areas in King County parks and recreation facilities and prescribing penalties. The ordinance would subject violators of the prohibition to citation for a civil infraction.
