NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 2nd day of March, 2015, at 1:30 p.m., to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2014-0488, authorizing the condemnation of real property on behalf of the Washington State Convention Center Public Facilities District in connection with the planned development of their new convention center, proposed to be located both on and under the property to be condemned as well as adjacent to and on the Convention Place Station Transit property in downtown Seattle, Washington. The address of the parcel to be condemned is 915 Howell Street, parcel number: 0660001133.

SUMMARY

The Washington State Convention Center Expansion Project will accommodate the growing demand for convention center space in Seattle, Washington—not able to be met by the current size and configuration of the existing convention center. The property interests to be condemned are necessary for the construction of the proposed and planned new convention center. This project is for a public purpose and benefit, it is necessary and in the best interests of the citizens of King County and the State of Washington. King County, by statute, is responsible for all eminent domain actions necessary for the activities of the Washington State Convention Center Public Facilities District. The Metropolitan King County Council intends to take final action to authorize condemnation of the properties listed in this notice.
