1 A MOTION proposing an honorary road name designation
2 in recognition of Northwood Middle School.

3 WHEREAS, the council, by motion, may propose an honorary road name
4 designation, consistent with K.C.C. 16.08.060, and

5 WHEREAS, SE 184th Street in the unincorporated community of Fairwood
6 intersects with Petrovitsky Road and runs adjacent to Kent School District #415, and

7 WHEREAS, Kent School District #415, otherwise known as Northwood Middle
8 School, is the sole property owner of the land along SE 184th Street, and

9 WHEREAS, Northwood Middle School was founded in 1996, and

10 WHEREAS, Northwood Middle School's mascot is the Jaguar, which was chosen
11 through community, school, student, and parent input and voting, and

12 WHEREAS, Northwood Middle School is expanding to include 6th grade in the
13 fall of 2023, and

14 WHEREAS, 560 students attend Northwood Middle School during the 2022-2023
15 school year and 852 students are expected to attend during the 2023-2024 school year,
16 and

17 WHEREAS, Northwood Middle School famous graduates include Olivia Van der
18 Jagt with the OL Reign of the National Women's Soccer League;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

20 A. The council proposed that SE 184th Street be given the honorary road name
21 designation "Jaguar Way" to honor Northwood Middle School and surrounding
22 community.

23 B. In accordance with K.C.C. 16.08.060.C.5., the road services division is
24 directed to prepare a list of the names and addresses of all affected property owners on
25 SE 184th Street. The list shall be sent electronically to the clerk of the council no later
26 than June 30, 2023, who shall provide an electronic copy to all councilmembers, the
27 council chief of staff, the chief policy officer, and the lead staff of the local services and
28 land use committee, or its successor.

29 C. Within ten days of receipt of the list of affected property owners from the road
30 services division, the clerk of the council shall mail to each affected property owner a
31 copy of this motion and a notice advising the affected property owners that the council
32 may introduce an ordinance to make the honorary road name designation. The notice
33 shall inform the affected property owners that the proposed honorary name designation
34 will not replace the legal name of the street or change their addresses, and that the costs
35 associated with installing and maintaining the honorary road name designation signage
36 shall be borne by the road services division or its successor. The notice shall provide that
37 members of the public may submit comments on the proposed honorary name
38 designation to the clerk of the council no later than July 31, 2023, and shall include both
39 email and regular postal mail addresses to which comments may be submitted. The clerk
40 of the council shall retain any submitted comments and provide, by August 10, 2023,
41 copies of submitted comments to all councilmembers, the council chief of staff, the chief





Electronic Record and Signature Disclosure

ELECTRONIC RECORD AND SIGNATURE DISCLOSURE

From time to time, King County-Department of 02 (we, us or Company) may be required by law to provide to you certain written notices or disclosures. Described below are the terms and conditions for providing to you such notices and disclosures electronically through the DocuSign system. Please read the information below carefully and thoroughly, and if you can access this information electronically to your satisfaction and agree to this Electronic Record and Signature Disclosure (ERSD), please confirm your agreement by selecting the check-box next to 'I agree to use electronic records and signatures' before clicking 'CONTINUE' within the DocuSign system.

Getting paper copies

At any time, you may request from us a paper copy of any record provided or made available electronically to you by us. You will have the ability to download and print documents we send to you through the DocuSign system during and immediately after the signing session and, if you elect to create a DocuSign account, you may access the documents for a limited period of time (usually 30 days) after such documents are first sent to you. After such time, if you wish for us to send you paper copies of any such documents from our office to you, you will be charged a \$0.00 per-page fee. You may request delivery of such paper copies from us by following the procedure described below.

Withdrawing your consent

If you decide to receive notices and disclosures from us electronically, you may at any time change your mind and tell us that thereafter you want to receive required notices and disclosures only in paper format. How you must inform us of your decision to receive future notices and disclosure in paper format and withdraw your consent to receive notices and disclosures electronically is described below.

Consequences of changing your mind

If you elect to receive required notices and disclosures only in paper format, it will slow the speed at which we can complete certain steps in transactions with you and delivering services to you because we will need first to send the required notices or disclosures to you in paper format, and then wait until we receive back from you your acknowledgment of your receipt of such paper notices or disclosures. Further, you will no longer be able to use the DocuSign system to receive required notices and consents electronically from us or to sign electronically documents from us.

All notices and disclosures will be sent to you electronically

Unless you tell us otherwise in accordance with the procedures described herein, we will provide electronically to you through the DocuSign system all required notices, disclosures, authorizations, acknowledgements, and other documents that are required to be provided or made available to you during the course of our relationship with you. To reduce the chance of you inadvertently not receiving any notice or disclosure, we prefer to provide all of the required notices and disclosures to you by the same method and to the same address that you have given us. Thus, you can receive all the disclosures and notices electronically or in paper format through the paper mail delivery system. If you do not agree with this process, please let us know as described below. Please also see the paragraph immediately above that describes the consequences of your electing not to receive delivery of the notices and disclosures electronically from us.

How to contact King County-Department of 02:

You may contact us to let us know of your changes as to how we may contact you electronically, to request paper copies of certain information from us, and to withdraw your prior consent to receive notices and disclosures electronically as follows:

To let us know of a change in your email address where we should send notices and disclosures electronically to you, you must send an email message to us at cipriano.dacanay@kingcounty.gov and in the body of such request you must state: your previous email address, your new email address. We do not require any other information from you to change your email address.

If you created a DocuSign account, you may update it with your new email address through your account preferences.

To request paper copies from King County-Department of 02

To request delivery from us of paper copies of the notices and disclosures previously provided by us to you electronically, you must send us an email to cipriano.dacanay@kingcounty.gov and in the body of such request you must state your email address, full name, mailing address, and telephone number. We will bill you for any fees at that time, if any.

To withdraw your consent with King County-Department of 02

To inform us that you no longer wish to receive future notices and disclosures in electronic format you may:

- i. decline to sign a document from within your signing session, and on the subsequent page, select the check-box indicating you wish to withdraw your consent, or you may;
- ii. send us an email to cipriano.dacanay@kingcounty.gov and in the body of such request you must state your email, full name, mailing address, and telephone number. We do not need any other information from you to withdraw consent.. The consequences of your withdrawing consent for online documents will be that transactions may take a longer time to process..

Required hardware and software

Acknowledging your access and consent to receive and sign documents electronically

Further, if you consent to receiving notices and disclosures exclusively in electronic format as described herein, then select the check-box next to ‘I agree to use electronic records and signatures’ before clicking ‘CONTINUE’ within the DocuSign system.
