13          WHEREAS, in Ordinance 15453 the King County council established a new  
14          citizens' elections oversight committee and adopted criteria for membership on the  
15          committee;

16          NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

17           The appointment of Marilyn L. Knight to the King County citizens' elections  
18 oversight committee, as a representative of a nonpartisan organization active in King  
19 County that provides elections information to the public, for a term to expire on  
20 September 18, 2008, is hereby confirmed.


