1 **AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2017-0232, VERSION 7**

2 Beginning on page 17, line 386, after "aging in King County." strike "Until either  
3 seventy-five percent of the number of those seniors, who are also veterans or military  
4 servicemembers in King County and who as of the date this ordinance is enacted are  
5 homeless, obtain housing or a total of twenty-four million dollars of the levy proceeds are  
6 spent for the purpose of housing seniors who are also veterans or military  
7 servicemembers in King County, whichever comes first, at least fifty percent of the levy  
8 proceeds described in this subsection shall be used to fund capital facilities and regional  
9 health and human services for seniors who are also veterans or military servicemembers  
10 and their respective caregivers and families." and insert: "Until either (a) seventy-five  
11 percent of the number of those seniors, who are also veterans or military servicemembers  
12 in King County and who as of the enactment date of this ordinance are homeless, obtain  
13 housing or (b) a total of twenty-four million dollars from the levy proceeds, except those  
14 levy proceeds described in subsection B.1. of this section, or from other funds  
15 administered by King County or both are spent to house seniors who are also veterans or  
16 military servicemembers in King County, at least fifty percent of the levy proceeds  
17 described in this subsection shall be used to fund capital facilities and regional health and

18 human services for seniors who are also veterans or military servicemembers and their  
19 respective caregivers and families."

20 **EFFECT: Would require that the \$24 million (to be spent for the purpose of**  
21 **housing seniors who are also veterans or military servicemembers in order to**  
22 **remove the restricted 50 percent of the seniors allocation) not be spent from the**  
23 **veterans allocation (subsection 4.B.1.). The \$24 million could be spent from other**  
24 **levy proceeds or other funds administered by King County.**
