5. Proposed Ordinance No. 2023-0210

AN ORDINANCE related to COVID-19; making a net supplemental appropriation of \$11,363,000 to several general fund agencies; making a net supplemental appropriation of \$19,959,000 to several non-general fund agencies; making a net supplemental appropriation of \$8,416,807 to several capital improvement funds; and amending the 2023-2024 Biennial Budget Ordinance, Ordinance 19546, Sections 17, 18, 32, 33, 40, 46, 46, 52, 57, 62, 65, 72, 72, 73, 83, 83, 91, 91, 94, 102, 107, 116, 120, 121, and 129, as amended, and Attachment A, as amended.
