

It's important to remember that TC4 – like nearly all large homeless encampments in King County – is run by the Seattle Housing and Resource Effort (SHARE). It's also important to understand that the "Marvin" in question here is almost certainly one Marvin Futrell, who has been employed by SHARE for several years as the on-site boss of one or another of SHARE's operations. You'll be hearing more about Mr. Futrell in a subsequent e-mail.

### **Significance of the Bellevue Police Report**

The police report is important for two reasons. First, it shows that, notwithstanding the many glowing accounts of the secure, drug-free conditions at homeless camps that the Council has heard from SHARE supporters, drugs *are* getting into the camps and camp security is poor. Be aware that Mr. Wosser's death is not the first drug overdose death that has occurred at a SHARE camp, nor is it likely to be the last. Second, the report shows that, far from helping officials to *protect* people at Tent City 4, SHARE staff actively obstructed those officials from doing their job. Local news stories from around King County have documented that SHARE refuses to give information on who is staying at their camps to government officials, even when that refusal puts camp residents and the public at risk.

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### **Attachment 3: Summary List of 9-1-1 Responses To Nickelsville (May, 2011 through April, 2013)**

I compiled this summary from three MS Excel spreadsheets the Seattle Police Department sent me in response to a public disclosure request. The list shows 104 police incident responses that happened at or near the (former) Highland Park location of Nickelsville. Nickelsville is a series of homeless encampments run by SHARE. In contrast to tent cities, Nickelsvilles are often unpermitted (that is, illegal) and they typically allow things that are not permitted under encampment legislation or local codes. For example, the Nickelsville encampment stayed in Highland Park for over two years illegally and didn't leave until it was forcibly evicted by the City of Seattle in late 2013. Nickelsvilles in Highland Park and downtown Seattle have also allow children to stay there. (During Nickelsville's stay in Highland Park, several children were removed by CPS and put into foster homes.)

(Note: Even though Nickelsvilles are not always under the County's jurisdiction, Nickelsville should always be on the County's radar, and there are several reasons for that, the most important of which is that Nickelsville is run by SHARE, the same organization that operates tent cities. Another reason the County should care about Nickelsville – even when it's not on County-controlled land – is that it usually ends up costing the County time and money anyway, as it did when the Health Department was forced to spend tens of thousands of dollars to ameliorate a rat infestation at the Highland Park location in late 2012.)

### **Significance of the Seattle Police Department Nickelsville summary report**

Just as the Bellevue Police report on the drug overdose death at Tent City 4 belies SHARE's claims about

drugs and security there, the SPD summary report belies SHARE's claims to Nickelsville's neighbors in Highland Park. Yes, SHARE told Highland Park residents – including me – the same lies they tell every other community: There are no drugs at Nickelsville, they said. There is no crime there. We will cooperate with the police to keep the bad people out . . .

But it was all just pretty words. The reality was much less glamorous.

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As I explained to the Committee of the Whole last Monday, the organization that runs these homeless camps has not acted in a reasonable or accountable fashion. There is no possible justification for refusing to cooperate with a police investigation, just as there is no reason for the citizens to tolerate a condition where drug dealers and other criminals use these camps as a refuge. In the weeks ahead, the Council is going to be hearing more from me on this matter, both via e-mail and in person, at the meetings. I have detailed, documented accounts of crimes committed by people at these camps. And worse: I have documented evidence of County officials lying to the press and looking the other way while the camp operator disregarded the law, along with numerous ethical violations committed by the camp operator and its employees.

As I said in my statement, until such time as the County can be assured that these camps are helping people get out of homelessness and the camp operators can be held accountable to the citizens for their actions, the County should not sanction even one more homeless camp within its borders.

Testimony of David Preston to the King County Council  
Re: Proposed 10-year Extension of Homeless Encampment Ordinance  
(Proposed Ordinance No. 2014-0424)

Monday, October 13, 2014

Dear Councilmembers:

Many of the people in King County's homeless camps are permanently homeless. Has the County done any studies on whether people in these camps are making it into housing? No, they haven't. Why not? Because the outfit that runs the camps won't tell anyone who's in them. Not even the police. On July 1st of this year, Bellevue cops responded to a drug-related death at Tent City 4. In their report, they noted that the man in charge . . . a guy named "Marvin" . . . refused to help them investigate what happened.

King County has waived thousands of dollars in permitting fees for this outfit, yet they can't even make them keep their camps clean and safe. The camp operators won't let the County check to verify that they're screening out criminals. As a result, criminals are getting in and crimes *are* being committed, both inside and outside the camp. Some of these crimes are serious. Here's a police report detailing 104 separate 9-1-1 incidents that occurred at a camp in my South Seattle neighborhood. The list includes beatings, theft, and another drug overdose.

Recently the County Health Department wasted tens of thousands of dollars trying to get rid of rats at one of the camps. They spent thousands more cleaning up a mountain of trash the camp left behind when it was evicted. Come on! Picking up trash is basic stuff. It's stuff camp operators should be doing, not the taxpayers. I've written Mr. Dembowski with details on this . . . sent him photos of the trash and records on clean-up costs . . . but he doesn't answer my e-mails. And now he's sponsoring a bill that will give these camps our formal blessing?

Mr. Dembowski, members of the council . . . please don't roll out the welcome mat for people who abuse our generosity! Don't perpetuate a system whereby people are made to live in permanent squalor and filth. Until you show us that you can make the operators of these camps pick up their trash and keep drugs and criminals out, you should NOT move forward with any new legislation.

Dear legal practitioner: Please take notice that we take reasonable precautions to prevent the disclosure of privileged or confidential materials, including those protected by the attorney-client privilege and/or work product doctrine, when responding to request for records. These precautions include, but are not limited to, carefully locating and assembling responsive records, performing an intra-departmental review of the records for purposes of determining whether they contain any privileged or confidential materials, forwarding the records to the County Prosecuting Attorney's Office for independent legal review, meeting and conferring with the Prosecuting Attorney's Office to compare and reconcile any conflicting results of our separate independent reviews and, if necessary, creating a withholding log. Despite our having taken these precautions, occasionally a mistake is made and privileged or confidential documents are inadvertently produced. To that end, we wanted to notify you that there is a possibility that the records being produced may contain privileged or confidential materials. The inadvertent or unintentional production

Lt Popochock arrived on scene and I informed him of the situation. Lt Popochock remained at scene and I went to the front desk area. While I was at the front desk a male named "Marvin" was also there. He informed the deceased male's name was "James Kendal". I asked him where the witnesses that were in the neighboring tents were and he initially ignored me. I pointed to two people partially blocked behind a wood divider and asked if they were the witnesses. He said they were filling out paperwork for the camp and that I could not talk to them. I asked him what their names were and he refused to tell me. I informed him that this was an open police investigation and whenever they were done with the paperwork for the camp that I would have to speak to them about what they witnessed. Marvin informed me that they did not have to talk with me and that they would not.

**Investigation:**

On 07/01/14 at approximately 2310 hours, I was dispatched to Tent City Four located at 15727 NE 4<sup>th</sup> ST to assist AID with a CPR patient that was not responding.

Upon arrival I was brought back to "tent 15" and there were multiple AID units administering CPR to a male on the ground in front of the tent. Firefighters Lewis and Archer informed me that they were first on scene. They were told by the people in the neighboring tents that they had heard something from inside the tent then contacted the front desk, also that the male had a seizure a few days prior. The firefighters located the male on the floor of the tent and he had a "weak pulse." They pulled him out of the tent and placed him on the ground directly in front of the tent and started to perform CPR. When they checked for a pulse again they were unable to locate one. Additional AID units arrived on scene and they were relieved from CPR.

At approximately 2321 hours, AID units pronounced the male deceased. The units on scene prior to my arrival did not notice any weapons, blood, or anything that raised suspicion at the scene or on the body. They visually noticed needles inside the tent. Due to the high volume of AID units I was unable to inspect the tent when I first arrived on scene but the exterior of the tent did not show any signs of foul play. Once the AID units cleared I visually inspected the body and did not notice any obvious signs of foul play or any inside the tent. I did noticed what appeared to be needle marks on his inside right elbow and needles inside the tent.

Lt Popochock arrived on scene and I informed him of the situation. Lt Popochock remained at scene and I went to the front desk area. While I was at the front desk a male named "Marvin" was also there. He informed the deceased male's name was "James Kendal". I asked him where the witnesses that were in the neighboring tents were and he initially ignored me. I pointed to two people partially blocked behind a wood divider and asked if they were the witnesses. He said they were filling out paperwork for the camp and that I could not talk to them. I asked him what their names were and he refused to tell me. I informed him that this was an open police investigation and whenever they were done with the paperwork for the camp that I would have to speak to them about what they witnessed. Marvin informed me that they did not have to talk with me and that they would not.

Officer Johnson arrived on scene and I informed her about Marvin being uncooperative and denying access to the witnesses. Marvin approached us and stood squared with his eyes wide and said, "They are not going to talk to you. How it works here is they have amenity and don't have to talk with you." At that point the situation was escalating with Marvin getting agitated and extremely uncooperative. I broke contact with him and notified Lt. Popochock of the situation. Lt Popochock went and spoke with Marvin while I stayed at the scene.

Lt. Popochock returned to the scene and informed me that Marcy Mead was the initially 911 caller and went inside the male's tent on instruction by the dispatcher. She saw the male on the floor and relayed informing to dispatch, then AID arrived on scene. Gary Padeker was in "tent 16" and heard noised from inside "tent 15." He is the one who notified Mead of what he heard but he never went inside the tent.

Marvin came to the scene and informed me that the deceased male's was possibly a "James Wasser". A female approached Lt. Popochock and said she knew the deceased man from high school and his name was "James Wosser." NORCOM conducted a check of all three provided names and the DOL photo matched to James J. Wosser (DOB: 09/22/61).

I contacted the Medical Examiner's Office and they informed me that they would be responding to the scene. Also, Detective Mangione was notified, arrived on scene, and took control of the scene. Please refer to Detective Mangione's report for further details.

The Medical Examiner arrived on scene and took custody of the body after their investigation. Please see M.E. Case #14-01191 for further details.

After the scene was cleared by the Detective Mangione and the M.E. Office, the tent and its belongings were released to the camp.

This ends my involvement in the case.

**SUPPLEMENTAL:**

On July 1, 2014 I responded to Tent City 4 for a death report. I contacted Officer Crist at the front entrance. Crist advised me that she was trying to get witness statements from a few people that initially witnessed the victim having a seizure. She said "Marvin" at the front desk told her they will write their statements out but they are not going to talk to officers nor are they going to give us their names.

Marvin walked over to me and proceeded to tell me the same thing. He said that the homeless already feel violated and by giving their names they feel violated all over again. He went on to say that we are violating the person's rights. Marvin also said that he knows how officers treat homeless people when they contact them on the street. Officers are insensitive to the homeless.

After dealing with Marvin I proceeded to the scene at the back of the camp. I observed victim James lying on the ground in front of his tent. I could see a hypodermic needle with an orange cap on the floor in his tent.

A male who would only identify himself as Kerry Brown walked up to the scene. He told me that he had been with James earlier in the day. Kerry said James got up at 0730 and had coffee. At 1100 he saw James leave in a car with a female. He returned at about 1145 and had a guitar and another bag with him. Kerry said James went to the smoke shack at about 1230 and was talking with him. James was excited for the following day because he was getting paid. After James finished smoking he went back to his tent. This is the last time Kerry remembers seeing James. Out of nowhere Kerry told me James was diabetic and not a drug addict.

I waited at the scene until the Medical Examiner arrived. I followed the ME out with the victim and signed off on their property sheet. At no time did I touch the victim or anything at the scene.

This concludes my involvement in this case.

## Follow Up:

On 07/02/14 at approx. 2400 Hrs. I was called at home to respond to a death investigation located at 15727 NE 4 St. The area in question was inside “Tent City 4” which was set up adjacent to the Temple (west side) at the listed address.

I arrived at approx. 0023 Hrs. and contacted Ofc. Crist who advised me that the initial call was a medical call for a seizure patient. The fire department arrived on scene and performed life saving measures but was not successful. The police department was then called to investigate. The identity of the person was unknown and the staff at Tent City 4 was uncooperative in providing police with the Vict’s identity. During the course of the investigation, Ofc. Crist saw drug paraphernalia inside the Vict’s tent. Ofc. Crist then advised that the medical examiner’s office had been called and they were en route.

I viewed the Vict. lying on the ground in front of his tent. The Vict. was lying in the supine position and was fully clothed wearing a t-shirt, jeans and shoes. Attached to the Vict. was medical intervention equipment on his body which was left in place by aid personnel after they ceased life-saving efforts. The medical equipment left behind was the following:

1. Resuscitation device left in the Vict’s mouth.
2. Intravenous line and solution bag in the Vict’s left arm.

I then photographed the Vict. in place then began to view the contents of the tent while waiting for the M.E. Investigator to arrive. While viewing the Vict., I observed what appeared to be 2 needle marks beside each other on the inside of the Vict’s right arm in the area of the elbow. It is unknown as to the age of the marks but given the redness, it appeared as though they might be relatively fresh marks. There was no blood in this area to indicate that they were recent marks that might relate to this call, however, the autopsy would be able to provide additional info.

As I viewed the interior of the tent I noticed syringes on the floor of the tent, copper mesh, cotton, tissue, lighters, glass crack/meth pipe and a small make shift pot for cooking drugs. I photographed these items and later confiscated them as evidence.

During the course of the search I also located prescription medicine bottles in the name of James Wosser. At this approx. time Ofc. Crist advised me that Tent City 4 staff was beginning to cooperate and provided the name of the Vict. which was then confirmed with a photograph from prior police contact.

The M.E. Investigator then arrived on scene and photographed the scene. The body was turned over and the Vict’s wallet was removed from his left rear pants pocket and his identity was confirmed via WA. State Driver’s license.

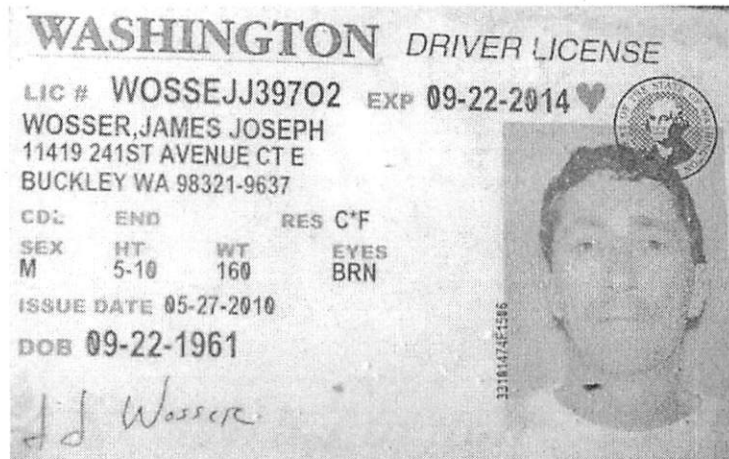

The M.E. then emptied the Vict's right front pants pocket and removed a glass crack/meth pipe and tissue. In the left front pants pocket was the Vict's cell phone. All of the items found on the Vict's person were retained by the M.E. Investigator during the autopsy. These items would later be returned to me as possible evidence in this case.

At my request, Ofc. Crist then conducted an inventory of the Vict's medications and noted several medications. Not all medications were in their appropriate bottles.

Of the medications listed, there were pills that were not identified as they were mixed with other medications or were in unmarked bottles. I conducted a check on [www.drugs.com](http://www.drugs.com) for the pill markings and noted the following:

Line 6 above:

TEVA 74 (Zolpidem 10 mg)

TCL 080 (Sennosides 8.6 mg)

Pill imprint TCL 080 has been identified as Sennosides 8.6 mg.

Senna is used in the treatment of constipation; bowel preparation and belongs to the drug class laxatives. Risk cannot be ruled out during pregnancy. Senna 8.6 mg is not subject to the Controlled Substances Act.

Given the location of where the Vict. died and the lack of security for the Vict's medications, I seized the medications and drug paraphernalia for safekeeping pending the outcome of this investigation as determined by the King County Medical Examiner. The remaining items belonging to the Vict. were put in the care of the administrators of tent city. They were advised that this would be considered a landlord tenant situation where they would be responsible for the security and storage of the Vict's belongings under the landlord tenant laws. The administrators on site understood and locked the Vict's tent that night with the intention of gathering and boxing the Vict's property the following day. Several overall photos of the Vict's property were taken to document what was left behind and were submitted with this case.

During the roughly 15 minute period that we were gathering our equipment, an unnamed woman approached me and stated that she was the person who called 911. She stated that she was in the tent directly south of the tent that the man was found in. She stated that she heard some noise, and found that the man was in what she described as a seizure. She stated that she called 911, and at the direction of the dispatcher, attempted to pull the man from the tent to see if he was breathing. She stated that she had been a "home health nurse" for 30 years, so she was comfortable trying to help him. She then stated that he had told her the previous day that he wanted to kill himself. I told her that I was a member of the Fire Department, and that the Police Department would likely interview her, and she could tell her story to the Police. She stood around for a few more minutes, and then went inside her tent, which was directly south of the tent that she found the man inside. Myself and the Ladder 3 crew remained on scene for a few more minutes. We left the scene at a time that there were 2 Bellevue Police officer's in immediate proximity to the deceased man and the tent.
