SUBJECT: A MOTION confirming the Executive's appointment of Stephanie Scott, who resides in Council District eight, to the King County Women's Advisory Board.

SUMMARY:

The executive has forwarded for council consideration and approval the following appointment:

Proposed Motion 2012-0011: The Executive has appointed Stephanie Scott to a to a three year term on the King County Women's Advisory Board, expiring July 1, 2014. Ms. Scott is a graduate of the University of Washington where she received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science. She is currently the Director of Communications for the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals International (SPCA). SPCA International is a small non-profit organization founded in 2006.

BACKGROUND:

The Women's Advisory Board makes recommendations to the King County Executive and the King County Council to ensure the needs; rights and well being of women are taken into account by County government. The Women's Advisory Board is composed of fifteen members. Each King County Council member nominates one person to represent his or her respective district. The County Council also nominates four individuals to serve in Council At-large Positions. The remaining 2 positions are at-large positions appointed by the Executive. Members serve 3 year terms and must represent the diversity of women in King County and shall not include employees or board members of agencies receiving funding from the Women's Program.
