Service for Rapidly Developing Areas

Commitments

- increase service to a yet-to-be-completed list of areas in the East and South Subareas
- add unspecified amounts of peak service where there is currently no service and mid-day service where there is currently only peak service

Service Partnership Program

Commitments

- set aside 90,000 hours
- add partnership hours at a rate not to exceed one-half of the total TN hours added in any year
- provide one-third or less of the operating costs for five years for financial partnerships
- develop partnership selection criteria
- for speed-and-reliability partnerships, provide 5,000 or more hours in return for corridor improvements increasing bus speed by ten-percent, twelve hours a day
