13                  that is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction

14                  shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the

15                  measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure,

18                  electors of King County, at a special election to be held in conjunction with the general
