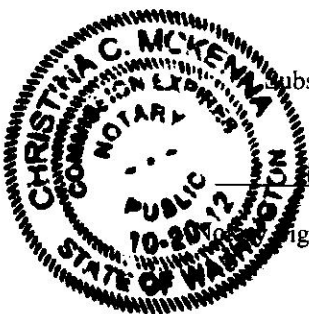

Resolution (FCD2012-06)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN,** that a public hearing will be held before the King County Flood Control Zone District ("District") Board of Supervisors, Room 1200, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 14th day of May, 2012, at 1:30 p.m., to consider adoption of Proposed Resolution FCD2012-06, which would authorize condemnation of property and property interests needed to carry out the Reddington Levee Setback Project.

The Assessor tax parcel numbers which are the subject matter of this resolution are as follows: 000420-0002; 000420-0007; 062105-9002; 000420-0003; 030140-1670; 030140-1680; and 030140-1690.

**SUMMARY**

The District Flood Hazard Management Plan recommends a project to set back the Reddington Levee, located on the left bank of the Green River in Auburn between 26th Street NE and S 277th Street, in order to address significant flood risks to people, property and infrastructure.

Before this project can proceed, the King County Flood Control Zone District must acquire certain real property interests and/or rights in property.

The King County Flood Control District intends to take final action to authorize condemnation of the properties listed in this notice.
