

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

The Riverview School District No. 407 has issued a determination of nonsignificance under the State Environmental Policy Act Rules (Chapter 197-11 WAC) for the following nonproject action:

Adoption of the Riverview School District's 2012 Capital Facilities Plan ("Capital Facilities Plan") for the purposes of planning for the District's facilities needs for the period 2012-2018. King County and the cities of Carnation and Duvall will incorporate the District's Capital Facilities Plan into their Comprehensive Plans.

After review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the agency, the Riverview School District has determined this proposal will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment.
