MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN KING COUNTY AND TEAMSTERS LOCAL 117

EXTENDING THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT CLA APPENDIX 352 COVERING SECURITY SCREENERS IN THE KING COUNTY SHERIFFS OFFICE

King County and Teamsters Local 117, having bargained in good faith, hereby agree as follows:

- 1. The terms of the Appendix for 352 that was set to expire on December 31, 2024, covering Security Screeners and Security Screener Leads within the King County Sheriff's Office, shall not open for successor bargaining in 2024. Upon full ratification of the successor 2021-2024 Coalition Labor Agreement ('21-'24 CLA), the terms and conditions of this memorandum of agreement (MOA) and of the 2021-2024 Appendix for 352 shall be incorporated into the successor agreement to the '21-'24 CLA. At the conclusion of CLA large table bargaining the parties agree to update the relevant, Appendix language to align with CLA language, as appropriate.
- 2. On the effective date of this MOA, Security Screeners pay shall be increased prospectively from pay range 34 to pay range 37, Security Screeners Lead pay shall be increased from pay range 37 to pay range 40.
- **3.** Addendum A of the Appendix for 352 shall be updated to read as follows;

ELECTRONIC RECORD AND SIGNATURE DISCLOSURE

From time to time, King County-Department of 02 (we, us or Company) may be required by law to provide to you certain written notices or disclosures. Described below are the terms and conditions for providing to you such notices and disclosures electronically through the DocuSign system. Please read the information below carefully and thoroughly, and if you can access this information electronically to your satisfaction and agree to this Electronic Record and Signature Disclosure (ERSD), please confirm your agreement by selecting the check-box next to 'I agree to use electronic records and signatures' before clicking 'CONTINUE' within the DocuSign system.

Getting paper copies

At any time, you may request from us a paper copy of any record provided or made available electronically to you by us. You will have the ability to download and print documents we send to you through the DocuSign system during and immediately after the signing session and, if you elect to create a DocuSign account, you may access the documents for a limited period of time (usually 30 days) after such documents are first sent to you. After such time, if you wish for us to send you paper copies of any such documents from our office to you, you will be charged a \$0.00 per-page fee. You may request delivery of such paper copies from us by following the procedure described below.

Withdrawing your consent

If you decide to receive notices and disclosures from us electronically, you may at any time change your mind and tell us that thereafter you want to receive required notices and disclosures only in paper format. How you must inform us of your decision to receive future notices and disclosure in paper format and withdraw your consent to receive notices and disclosures electronically is described below.

Consequences of changing your mind

If you elect to receive required notices and disclosures only in paper format, it will slow the speed at which we can complete certain steps in transactions with you and delivering services to you because we will need first to send the required notices or disclosures to you in paper format, and then wait until we receive back from you your acknowledgment of your receipt of such paper notices or disclosures. Further, you will no longer be able to use the DocuSign system to receive required notices and consents electronically from us or to sign electronically documents from us.

All notices and disclosures will be sent to you electronically

Unless you tell us otherwise in accordance with the procedures described herein, we will provide electronically to you through the DocuSign system all required notices, disclosures, authorizations, acknowledgements, and other documents that are required to be provided or made available to you during the course of our relationship with you. To reduce the chance of you inadvertently not receiving any notice or disclosure, we prefer to provide all of the required notices and disclosures to you by the same method and to the same address that you have given us. If you do not agree with this process, please let us know as described below. To request delivery from us of paper copies of the notices and disclosures previously provided by us to you electronically, you must send us an email to cipriano.dacanay@kingcounty.gov and in the body of such request you must state your email address, full name, mailing address, and telephone number. We will bill you for any fees at that time, if any.

To withdraw your consent with King County-Department of 02

To inform us that you no longer wish to receive future notices and disclosures in electronic format you may:

i. decline to sign a document from within your signing session, and on the subsequent page, select the check-box indicating you wish to withdraw your consent, or you may;

ii. send us an email to cipriano.dacanay@kingcounty.gov and in the body of such request you must state your email, full name, mailing address, and telephone number. We do not need any other information from you to withdraw consent. The consequences of your withdrawing consent for online documents will be that transactions may take a longer time to process.
