It is expected that the Council will take action on this Proposed Ordinance at the November 26, 2024, meeting following the public hearing.

SUMMARY:

The Proposed Ordinance would which adopt findings in support of and extend an existing moratorium by six months, prohibiting the acceptance of applications for the establishment of new or expansion of existing wineries, breweries, distilleries, and remote tasting rooms, as primary or accessory uses or as home occupations or home industries; and prohibiting temporary use permits for wineries, breweries, distilleries, and remote tasting rooms.
