Scope of Work: An ordinance revising the King County Mitigation Payment System (MPS)

> Code Sections 14.75.040 and 14.75.100. The ordinance updates the King County MPS fee schedule to reflect the termination of the reciprocal MPS Interlocal Agreement the County has with the City of Issaquah that will terminate on November 13, 2009. The changes to the code include removal of the City of Issaquah projects, reflecting how the fees charged by the County are

changed, setting the mitigation payment system program project list and pro-

viding for an updated road mitigation payment system fee schedule.
