Ms. Drago briefed the Council on Sound Transit. The Board heard a briefing on the east link. She indicated analysis of route options continues and there will be further discussion at the upcoming capital committee meeting. Public testimony was heard and many letters received. Representatives from the city of Bellevue, the Bellevue Downtown Association, Bellevue Chamber and Bellevue residents testified. The Board approved a motion to allow CEO Joni Earl to move forward with property acquisition for staging areas for the Brooklyn and Roosevelt stations. Sound Transit contracted with the city of Seattle for the planning and construction of the First Hill street car. Sound Transit endorsed a Broadway run.

Ms. Patterson reported on the Sound Transit Executive Committee. The members discussed fares and fare policy and considered a proposal that would create a single fare policy for the organization. The Board discussed a resolution relating to new fare rates and its structure. Sound Transit's bus fares are relatively low. Operating costs have gone up and projected fare box recovery ratio for Sound Transit Express is going to fall below the 20% target. Sound Transit is looking at increasing fares over the course of the next two years.

Ms. Patterson reported on the Forecast Council and indicated the Council voted on the confidence measure which the executive branch will use when developing the 2011 budget.
