Proposed Ordinance 2019-0137**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington on the 10th day of July, 2019 at 10:30 a.m., to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2019-0137.

Proposed Ordinance 2019-0137 does the following:

- Makes three changes to King County Code Sections 2.12 and 2.14.
 1. Proposed Ordinance 2019-0137 would amend K.C.C. Section 2.12 related to the fees charged to requestors receiving public records aligning K.C.C. with Washington State law RCW 42.56.120.
 2. Proposed Ordinance 2019-0137 would amend K.C.C. Section 2.12 to change the contents of the departmental public records officer performance and lawsuit reports that are included in the annual Public Records Committee report transmitted to Council in April. This change would remove reporting requirements related to whether five-day response requirements were met and explanations for the length of requests that were six months or older.
 3. Proposed Ordinance 2019-0137 would change the date by which the PRC annual report is transmitted to Council from April to July.
