15 WHEREAS, on June 2, 2026, in accordance with K.C.C. 2.53.021, the
16 employment and administration committee appointed Steve Cho to the citizens' elections
17 oversight committee, for the remainder of that position's three-year term, to expire on
18 July 15, 2026, and to a new three-year term, to expire on July 15, 2029;

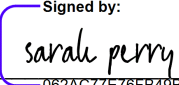

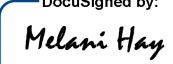
