Dear Councilmember Upthegrove:

This letter transmits a proposed Ordinance that, if enacted, will enable King County to sell the surplus parcel known as the Redondo Heights Park and Ride located at 27454 Pacific Hwy. S, Federal Way, Washington, to the Federal Way Public Schools in support of the provision of King County operations and services.

This transaction is recommended per the rationale and considerations provided in the attached property summary.

Pursuant to King County Code 4.56.140 and Revised Code of Washington 39.33.020, this proposed intergovernmental transfer of surplus real property requires public notice, a press release, and a public hearing. The public notice is required to be published in an area newspaper at least ten days but no more than twenty-five days prior to the hearing. A hearing notice and a press release are attached.
