1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the county property tax
2 levies for collection in 2005, and implementing RCW
3 84.55.120.

6 SECTION 1. The council is under an obligation by charter to enact revenue
7 measures that support the budget appropriation ordinance by December 1, 2004 for the
8 2005 budget. This ordinance sets the amount of property tax to be collected for the
9 regular property tax levy, the road district levy, the conservation futures levy and the
10 emergency medical services levy. In accordance with RCW 84.55.120, the council has
11 given proper notice of this ordinance to the public.

12 SECTION 2. For collection of the property tax levies in 2005, the council hereby
13 authorizes property tax increases over the amounts authorized for collection in 2004 as
14 follows:

Levy	Estimated Dollar Increase	% Increase	Estimated Total Levy
Regular	\$2,765,878	1%	\$279,353,670

Road District	\$3,869,452	6%	\$68,360,311
Emergency Medical Services	\$554,750	1%	\$56,029,706
Conservation Futures	\$138,490	1%	\$13,987,453

15 The increases shown above are exclusive of any amounts resulting from new construction
16 valued in 2004, any increases in value of state-assessed property for 2004 and any
17 amounts necessary to fund tax refunds paid in 2004.


18 SECTION 3. Upon enactment, the clerk is directed to forward this ordinance to
