1 AN ORDINANCE approving the Skyway Water & Sewer
2 District 2013 Comprehensive Plan Water & Sewer
3 Systems.

4 STATEMENT OF FACTS:

- 5 1. King County has adopted K.C.C. chapter 13.24, which requires
6 approval of comprehensive plans for water and sewer utilities that provide
7 service in unincorporated King County as a prerequisite for operating in
8 unincorporated King County, receiving approval for annexation proposals,
9 being granted right of way franchises, and being given approval for right
10 of way construction permits. K.C.C. chapters 13.24 and 28.84 and chapter
11 58.17 RCW prescribe the requirements for approval of such plans,
12 including consistency with state and local planning requirements.
- 13 2. The Skyway Water & Sewer District's last comprehensive plan was
14 prepared in 2005. Washington state Department of Ecology, Washington
15 state Department of Health and King County regulations require water and
16 sewer system plans to be updated every six years.
- 17 3. The district's service area is within King County and the district has
18 adopted a comprehensive plan update ("the plan").

19 4. King County has adopted a Comprehensive Plan that includes water
20 and wastewater policies in its provisions for facilities and services
21 (applicable portions of policies F-201 through F-264) that call for
22 consistency with other adopted plans, pursuit of reclaimed water, water
23 conservation and protection of water resources.

24 5. K.C.C. chapter 13.24 requires the utilities technical review committee
25 to review and make a recommendation to the King County executive and
26 council on the plan, the requirements under K.C.C. chapter 13.24 and
27 consistency with the King County Comprehensive Plan. The utilities
28 technical review committee has reviewed the planning data and district
29 operations and has found:

30 a. The plan uses population and employment forecasts developed by the
31 Puget Sound Regional Council and acknowledges the housing and job
32 growth targets adopted by the Growth Management Planning Council for
33 the district's service area;

34 b. A portion of the district's service area is in unincorporated King
35 County;

36 c. The capital facility plan is adequate to meet anticipated facility and
37 service needs;

38 d. The plan is consistent with applicable Washington state water quality
39 laws; and

40 e. The plan is consistent with other pertinent county adopted plans and
41 policies.

42 6. Washington state Department of Ecology and Washington state
43 Department of Health approval is pending upon King County's approval
44 of the plan.

45 7. Under the state Environmental Policy Act the district issued a
46 Determination of Nonsignificance for the plan on September 12, 2013.
47 There were no appeals.

48 8. The district's operations and facilities meet multiple existing statutory,
49 administrative and planning standards. As the district's operations,
50 facilities and planning meet the requirements of the King County Code
51 and are consistent with the King County Comprehensive Plan, the utilities
52 technical review committee has recommended approval of the plan.

53 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

54 SECTION 1. The Skyway Water & Sewer District 2013 Comprehensive Plan

55 Water & Sewer Systems, Attachment A to this ordinance, is hereby approved as a

56 comprehensive water and sewer system plan.
