1 A MOTION authorizing the finance and business
2 operations division to accept 2010 and 2011 donations to
3 the county general fund from the county executive, the
4 prosecuting attorney, the county assessor, the director of
5 elections, the county sheriff and members of the county
6 council.

7 WHEREAS, the county general fund faces an estimated sixty million dollar
8 shortfall in 2011, and

9 WHEREAS, the county executive, the prosecuting attorney, the county assessor,
10 the director of elections, the county sheriff and one or more members of the county
11 council have chosen or may choose to forego any increase in their salaries in 2011 in
12 order to mitigate the impacts of the county's 2011 general fund shortfall, and

13 WHEREAS, the salaries of superior and district court judges are established by
14 the Washington Citizens' Commission on Salaries for Elected Officials and have been
15 frozen since September 2008, and

16 WHEREAS, the salaries of nonjudicial elected county officials are established by
17 law, and

18 WHEREAS, to forego a salary increase for 2011, nonjudicial elected officials
19 must donate the increase to the county, and

20 WHEREAS, the King County Code requires that the county council accept by
21 motion donations to the general fund in excess of two thousand dollars, and

22 WHEREAS, the value of each elected official's donation will exceed two
23 thousand dollars for each year;

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


25 The finance and business operations division is authorized to accept from the
26 county executive, the prosecuting attorney, the county assessor, the director of elections,
27 the county sheriff and the members of the county council a 2010 and a 2011 donation to
28 the county general fund of a specific dollar amount that is based on a percentage of

29 annual salary, increase in annual salary or some combination thereof, as determined by
30 each individual.

County Council on 10/25/2010, by the following vote:


