Description of request:

Funds the DPH COVID response in January and February 2021 for the following: Testing, Contact Tracing, Care Coordination, I&Q Patient Services, MAT/Strike Team/Outbreak Testing, Call Center, PIO, HMAC, Admin; Community Mitigation and Recovery (community navigators, language access and task forces). Also includes the Safestart program in Environmental Health to emphasize outreach and education to taverns and restaurants, provide technical assistance, and implement progressive enforcement for non-compliance up to and including food permit suspension.

This request includes a request for incremental appropriation authority above the \$10.7M previously appropriated for COVID response in 2021. The revenue sources supporting these expenditures included State consolidated contracts revenue sources. The difference between expenditures and revenues is covered by revenue realized in 2020 and available in the Public Health fund balance.
