The WaterShed is an aquatic center promoting the creative use of water in Seattle's urban landscape. It:

- ◆ Creates swimming pools, ponds, streams & wetlands for exercise, play & education.
- ◆ Provides year-round facilities highlighting the diverse uses of water in all seasons.
- ◆ Showcases renewable energy systems and innovations in hydrology & urban ecology.

WHERE

The WaterShed sits above west GasworksPark, along Lake Union's north shore, it:

- ◆ Preserves one of the last open spaces looking out over Seattle's spectacular cityscape.
- ◆ Offers direct access to the Burke-Gilman trail.
- ◆ Creates an urban oasis; merging natural systems with the site's topography & historic structures.

WHY

The WaterShed inspires civic stewardship & promotes public health through interaction with Seattle's extraordinary aquatic resources, it:

- ◆ Fulfills the 2002 Wallingford Neighborhood Plan specifying an aquatic center for this site.
- ◆ Integrates, filters, and collects run-off from streets and roofs, using the site's natural slopes & terraces.
