12	WHEREAS, in Ordinance 15453 the King County council established a new
13	citizens' elections oversight committee and adopted criteria for membership on the
14	committee;
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
16	The appointment of Sheryl Moss to the King County citizens' elections oversight
17	committee, as a representative of the Office of the Secretary of State, serving in an ex

officio, nonvoting capacity, for a term to expire on a date to be determined by the Office
of the Secretary of State, is hereby confirmed.
