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"SECTION 2. The department of natural resources and parks shall adopt a public rule by June 30, 2019, addressing the fees and charges to industrial users to implement this ordinance. The department shall notify the clerk of the council of the adoption of the rule by filing with the clerk a paper original and an electronic copy of a notice that cites section 3 of this ordinance and specifies that the rule is adopted.

SECTION 3. Section 1 of this ordinance takes effect only upon the effective date of the public rule implementing this ordinance adopted in accordance with section 2 of this ordinance."

EFFECT: Modifies the authority granted to the wastewater treatment division manager to establish parameters which may be used to determine discharged waste strength and volume. Additionally, authorizes the Department of natural resources and parks to adopt a public rule addressing fees and charges to industrial users and makes the ordinance effective date contingent upon the implementation of that public rule.
