3 the needs of low-income, elderly, disabled and young

7 WHEREAS, King County provides transit services to its citizens to increase
8 mobility options and reduce traffic congestion and related environmental degradation,
9 and

10 WHEREAS, the provision of passenger vans to groups serving individuals with
11 limited resources and mobility options will support those goals and provide significant
12 public benefits, and

13 WHEREAS high-quality passenger vans retaining substantial value and utility are
14 periodically retired from the county's vanpool program, and

15 WHEREAS, the metropolitan King County council has previously transferred
16 retired vans to agencies serving low-income, elderly, disabled and young people, and

17 WHEREAS, the council provided for the transfer of twenty-six additional vans in
18 the 2005 Metro transit division budget;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:




