## AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2021-0372, VERSION 2

- 2 On page 103, on line 2351, after "Transit" strike "(\$5,150,000)" and insert "(\$5,750,000)"
- 4 On page 103, on line 2358, after "Transit" strike "\$59,689,000" and insert "\$60,689,000"
- 6 On page 103, on line 2359, after "additional FTEs for transit shall be:" strike "242.1" and
- 7 insert "245.1"

9 On page 105, after line 2394, insert:

- Of this appropriation, \$400,000 shall be expended or encumbered solely to:
- 12 A. Hire staff, continue design, planning or project delivery work, prepare for

21	On page 105 beginning on line 2395, strike everything through page 107 line 2439 and
22	insert:
23	"P1 PROVIDED THAT:
24	A. Of this appropriation, \$600,000 shall not be expended or encumbered until the
25	executive transmits a RapidRide restart report and a motion that should acknowledge
26	receipt of the report and a motion acknowledging receipt of the report is passed by the
27	council. The motion should reference the subject matter, the proviso's ordinance number,
28	ordinance section and proviso number in both the title and body of the motion.
29	B. In recognition of the fact that ((three)) two named RapidRide lines (which are
30	the R (Rainier)((, J (Roosevelt))) and K (Totem Lake/Bellevue/Eastgate)), which were
31	planned to be implemented during 2024 and 2025, and for which community engagement
32	and capital planning efforts have already been initiated, have been proposed to be
33	deferred indefinitely, the report shall address the Metro transit department's efforts to
34	implement these deferred lines as quickly as possible, including, but not limited to:
35	1. Efforts to be undertaken during 2022 to hire staff, continue design, planning
36	or project delivery work, prepare for community and partner engagement or otherwise
37	prepare and present detailed capital program proposals and timelines for both the K and R
38	RapidRide lines as part of the proposed 2023-2024 biennial budget;
39	2. For the K Line, a description of work already completed or planned to be
40	undertaken during 2022 to make progress on planning for the K Line to reach three to

41	five percent project design completed, based on the fact that work on the K Line was
42	paused with approximately one percent project design completed, as well as a description
43	of efforts to be undertaken during 2022 to prepare to begin the next phase of work on the
44	K Line during the 2023-2024 biennium;
45	3. For the R Line, a description of work already completed or planned to be
46	undertaken during 2022 to make progress on planning for the R Line to prepare to
47	transition from the planning phase to the project delivery phase, based on the fact that
48	work on the R Line was paused with approximately ten percent project design completed
49	as well as a description of efforts to be completed during 2022 to prepare to begin the
50	next phase of work on the R Line during the 2023-2024 biennium;
51	4. Efforts to secure grant or partner funding for capital improvements or
52	operational costs and a timeline for when the Metro transit department plans to seek gran
53	or partner funding for each line;
54	((2. The status of)) 5. A plan for ongoing partner and community engagement
55	and planning efforts for these deferred lines during the 2023-2024 biennium;
56	((3. The status of)) 6. A plan for ongoing alignment and capital planning efforts
57	for these deferred lines during the 2023-2024 biennium; and
58	((4. The status of these deferred lines in the interim service network included in
59	the proposed update to METRO CONNECTS, with the expectation that these three
60	deferred lines will be prioritized for implementation in METRO CONNECTS and other
61	proposed policy documents; and
62	5.)) 7. A proposed timeline for implementation for each of the deferred lines
63	based on the fact that both the K and R lines are proposed to be part of the Metro

64	Connects interim network, as proposed through Ordinance XXXXX (Proposed Ordinance
65	2021-0286).

- C. ((Two of the three deferred RapidRide lines, the J line and t)) The R line((; are)) is being implemented in partnership with the city of Seattle. As a result, although ((these lines have)) the line has been deferred, operational analysis and planning efforts have already been undertaken. The K line, however, is being implemented by King County, which has not yet completed operational analysis and planning. To ensure that preparation for the K line is at the same level ((as the other two deferred lines)) and that ((all three)) both lines are able to move forward when funding is available, the report shall summarize operational analysis and planning efforts that have been completed related to the RapidRide K line and the surrounding area, including, but not limited to:
- 1. Identification of a list of priorities and key projects in the area of the RapidRide K line that would support future interagency agreements or grant funding opportunities, as well as future environmental permitting requirements;
- 2. A description of the Metro transit department's work with Sound Transit regarding coordination between planning for the RapidRide K line with East Link light rail and I-405 bus rapid transit; ((and))
- 3. A description of the work already completed or planned to be undertaken during 2022 to make progress on planning for the K Line to reach three to five percent project design completed, based on the fact that work on the K Line was paused with approximately one percent project design completed;

85	4. A description of work to be undertaken during 2022 that will identify key
86	improvements for the K Line that could feasibly be advanced during the 2023-2024
87	timeline; and
88	5. A description of the next steps and needed budget that would be required to
89	proceed ((further)) during the 2023-2024 biennium with design and environmental
90	analysis for the RapidRide K line.
91	D. The executive should electronically file the report and the motion required by
92	this proviso no later than March 30, 2022, with the clerk of the council, who shall retain
93	an electronic copy and provide an electronic copy to all councilmembers, the council
94	chief of staff and the lead staff for the mobility and environment committee, or its
95	successor."

97	EFFECT prepared by M. Bourguignon: The amendment would appropriate \$400,000
98	of Metro Transit fund balance and add 3.0 FTEs to support the following:
99	1. activities to prepare and present detailed capital program proposals and
100	timelines for both the K and R RapidRide lines as part of the proposed 2023-
101	2024 biennial budget;
102	2. make progress on planning for the K Line to reach three to five percent project
103	design completed; and
104	3. make progress on planning for the R Line to prepare to begin the next phase of
105	work during the 2023-2024 biennium.

107	The amendment would also amend existing Proviso P1 related to the RapidRide restart
108	report to have Metro Transit report on the 2022 efforts on the K and R RapidRide lines
109	and plans for ongoing efforts on the K and R RapidRide lines during the 2023-2024
110	biennium.
