1	A MOTION requesting the parks division of the			
2	department of natural resources and parks to work with the			
3	cities of Bellevue and Redmond and community partners to			
4	evaluate and support the possibility of constructing a major			
5	league cricket facility in Marymoor park, and to provide a			
6	briefing to the council.			
7	WHEREAS, cricket is the second most popular sport in the world, yet has little			
8	media presence in the United States, and			
9	WHEREAS, there are an estimated twenty million cricket fans in the United			
10	States, and			
11	WHEREAS, cricket is a popular sport globally with multicultural appeal for			
12	residents, workers and children across King County, and			
13	WHEREAS, King County has a large population of foreign-born residents,			
14	including approximately one hundred thousand foreign-born residents from regions			
15	where cricket is popular, including South Asia, the United Kingdom, and Oceania, based			
16	on 2019 data, and			
17	WHEREAS, based on 2019 data, the percentage of foreign-born residents from			
18	South Asian countries was roughly fifteen percent for the entire King County, and the			
19	percentage is higher for the cities of Bellevue and Redmond, at roughly twenty eight			
20	percent and forty three percent, respectively, and			

21	WHEREAS, over the last decade, King County's South Asian population has		
22	increased by over one hundred percent, and		
23	WHEREAS, the lack of infrastructure and amenities for cricket in King County		
24	represents an equity issue, especially as the county continues to grow and become more		
25	diverse and multicultural, and		
26	WHEREAS, thousands of adult, youth and recreational cricketers are currently		
27	underserved by existing recreational cricket facilities in King County, and		
28	WHEREAS, King County is home to hundreds of exceptionally talented youth		
29	cricketers who would benefit from greater access to facilities and opportunities in our		
30	region so they could continue to cultivate their skills, and		
31	WHEREAS, King County is being considered as one of the founding locations for		
32	a major league cricket team for the inaugural 2023 season, and the availability of a		
33	professional cricket facility is likely to be a determinative factor as to whether King		
34	County is selected as a founding location, and		
35	WHEREAS, a professional, multipurpose cricket facility located in King County		
36	would attract tourists and cricketers from around the world and promote community		
37	building for residents across our region, and		
38	WHEREAS, a professional multipurpose cricket facility can generate significant		
39	local economic impact through ancillary community spending, event spending and venue		
40	construction, and could also be used a venue for other community events, including		
41	concerts, and		
42	WHEREAS, the United States will be cohosting the 2024 Cricket World Cup for		
43	the first time and King County would be competitive to host matches if a facility was

44	available, generating significant economic impact, tourism and a worldwide television
45	audience of more than a billion people, and
46	WHEREAS, regional stakeholders including the city of Bellevue, city of
47	Redmond, Seattle Sports Commission, Visit Bellevue, One Redmond, the Bellevue
48	Chamber and local employers have all engaged in conversations about bringing Major
49	League Cricket to the region, and
50	WHEREAS, at its November 1, 2021, meeting, the Bellevue City Council passed
51	a verbal motion directing Bellevue city staff to explore the opportunity to redevelop and
52	repurpose a Bellevue Utilities-owned property within Marymoor park for a major league
53	cricket facility, and
54	WHEREAS, Marymoor park is one of the jewels of the King County parks
55	system and would become even more vibrant and welcoming if it included a world-class
56	cricket facility, and
57	WHEREAS, adding additional cricket facilities to the King County parks system
58	would align with and further King County's equity and social justice goals, and
59	WHEREAS, many King County residents have not had the opportunity to play or
60	watch cricket and siting this facility at Marymoor park would introduce many people to
61	this exciting sport, and
62	WHEREAS, the council welcomes the efforts to seize this once-in-a-generation
63	opportunity to develop a multipurpose cricket facility and thanks the cities of Bellevue
64	and Redmond for exploring this opportunity, which would strengthen our community,
65	provide economic benefits, and support youth and adult cricketers in King County;
66	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 67 The council requests that the parks division of the department of natural resources
- 68 and parks and the department of local services, permitting division:
- A. Work with the cities of Bellevue and Redmond and community stakeholders
- 70 to evaluate the possibility of using the city of Bellevue Utilities property in Marymoor
- 71 park, parcel number 122505-9195, for a cricket facility, and make every effort to make
- the project a success; and

- 73 B. Provide a briefing to the transportation, economy and environment committee,
- 74 or its successor, on the status of the project no later than March 2022.
