Proposed Ordinance 2021-0468

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council on the 22nd day of March, 2022 at 1:00 p.m., to consider Proposed Ordinance 2021-0468, relating to the condemnation of certain properties required for the Cool Creek Sewer Upgrade project. The public hearing is planned to either be held at the King County Courthouse, 516 3rd Avenue, Room 1001, Seattle, Washington; or the hearing may be required to be held remotely to comply with the Washington State Governor's Declaration 20-28 (or as amended) regarding the Open Public Meetings Act. Information on this public hearing, including how to submit public testimony and attend the meeting, will be posted on the Council's website ahead of the hearing.

It is expected that the full Council will take action on this Proposed Ordinance at the March 22 meeting following the public testimony.

SUMMARY
The Cool Creek Sewer Upgrade project will replace aging sewer infrastructure that is nearing operational capacity. The project will also allow King County to continue to provide safe, reliable sewer service. The property interests to be obtained are necessary for construction of the conveyance facility. The Cool Creek Sewer Upgrade project is necessary for a public purpose and is in the best interest of the residents and wastewater ratepayers of King County. 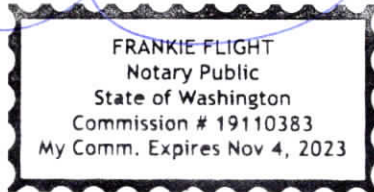
