This letter transmits a proposed Ordinance that, if enacted, would enable King County to grant a 20 year nonexclusive easement to the Seattle Public Schools for property located at 1211 East Alder Street, Seattle, Washington for the purposes of operating the school at King County's Children and Family Justice Center. King County Code requires permanent easements granted by the County and valued at over \$50,000 to be subject to approval by ordinance.

This transaction is recommended per the rationale and considerations provided in the attached property summary.

This proposed easement supports the King County Strategic Plan goal of efficient, accountable regional and local government.
