27	city of Issaquah in 2018, as part of Ordinance 18985.
28	7. The county council held the legally required public hearing and has
29	considered the criteria in RCW 57.02.040 and entered findings of fact per
30	RCW 57.28.080.
31	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
32	SECTION 1. The withdrawal of approximately 247 acres of land from the
33	Sammamish Plateau water and sewer district to the city of Issaquah, for the purpose of
34	water service described in Attachment A to this ordinance is approved. Approval of this
35	proposed withdrawal is consistent with RCW 57.02.040.
36	SECTION 2. The city of Issaquah is the appropriate entity to serve the area
37	proposed to be withdrawn.

# WATER DE-ANNEXATION, ISSAQUAH HIGHLANDS & URBAN VILLAGE – LAKESIDE

MARCH 7TH, 2022

THAT PORTION OF THE SOUTHWEST AND THE SOUTHEAST QUARTERS OF SECTION 22 AND THE SOUTHWEST AND THE SOUTHEAST QUARTERS OF SECTION 23, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 24 NORTH, RANGE 6 EAST, W.M., IN KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SAID SECTION 22; THENCE WEST ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID SECTION 22, A DISTANCE OF 3,315 FEET TO THE WEST LINE OF THE EAST HALF OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SAID SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 22;


