1 **AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2022-02374, VERSION 2**

2 On page 66, strike lines 1479 through 1484, and insert:

3 "ER6 EXPENDITURE RESTRICTION:

4 Of this appropriation, moneys shall not be expended or encumbered in 2024 to
5 support the law enforcement assisted diversion ("LEAD") program defined in MIDD
6 initiative CD-01 unless a competitive procurement is completed in 2023 and until a
7 contract or contracts, resulting from that competitive process, to operate the LEAD
8 program is fully executed. Nothing in this expenditure restriction shall be construed to
9 change the service components or design and goals of the LEAD program as described in
10 detail in subsections 1.A. and 1.B. of MIDD 2 Initiative CD-01: Law Enforcement
11 Assisted Diversion (LEAD) in the Mental Illness and Drug Dependency 2
12 Implementation Plan. LEAD shall continue to be a program designed to divert from the
13 justice system individuals engaged in low-level drug crime, prostitution and other
14 collateral crime due to drug involvement, bypassing prosecution and jail time, to directly
15 connect drug-involved individuals to case managers who can provide immediate
16 assessment and crisis response, and long-term outreach-based case management, to help
17 individuals with behavioral health issues to avoid coming into repeated contact with the
18 criminal justice system."
