Proposed No. 2022-0387.2 **Sponsors** McDermott 1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the 2022 levy of property 2 taxes in King County for collection in the year 2023. 3 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY: 4 SECTION 1. In accordance with RCW 84.48.130, the county assessor of King 5 County has certified to the metropolitan King County council that the regular assessed 6 valuation of the County of King as finally equalized amounts to \$875,837,390,002. 7 SECTION 2. The metropolitan King County council certifies to the county 8 assessor of King County the amount of taxes levied to fund estimated expenditures for 9 the year 2023 as listed in this section. These amounts do not include the total of 10 estimated revenues from sources other than taxation, including available surplus and such 11 expenditures as are to be net from bond warrant issues. In accordance with chapter 84.48 12 RCW, the King County assessor calculated a sum for property taxes available to the 13 county related to new construction, improvements to property, refunds, and any increase 14 in the assessed value of state assessed property.
