Proposed No. 23-01.1 **Sponsors** 1 A RESOLUTION designating the order in which the vice-2 chairs of the King County Board of Health may act in the 3 absence of the chair in 2023. 4 WHEREAS, on April 16, 2009, the King County Board of Health adopted 5 operating rules for the board through BOH R&R 09-04, and 6 WHEREAS, on May 19, 2021, the King County Board of Health adopted BOH 7 R&R 22-02 updating the membership of the board in accordance with Chapter 205, Laws 8 of Washington 2021, modifying the structure of local boards of health, and 9 WHEREAS, the adopted operating rules state that the board shall designate 10 annually two vice-chairs, one representing the city and county officials, and one 11 representing nonelected members, and 12 WHEREAS, the adopted operating rules state that, in the absence of the chair, a 13 vice-chair will exercise the duties, powers and prerogatives of the chair, and 14 WHEREAS, the adopted operating rules state that each year the board shall 15 designate by resolution the order in which the vice-chairs may act in absence of the chair, 16 and 17 WHEREAS, the adopted operating rules state that the order of the vice-chairs
